Life in the Department of Public Works

The month of June was a busy month for the DPW as we, Bill and Ryan, helped with preparations for the Fourth of July Celebration. This included signage, barricades, water and electrical hook ups, mowing of the rodeo/derby arena and other general duties associated with the Celebration. It was great working together with the Chamber of Commerce and many volunteers to help ensure that this year's Celebration was one to remember.

We continue to work diligently for you in the area of our daily responsibilities. These include mowing of Village properties, ensuring that you receive quality water on tap, brush pick up, road maintenance, equipment repairs amongst many other things.

We have appreciated all the support that we have received as we have tried to make this transition as smooth as possible. We will continue to move forward and work hard for this community and its residents.

Fire Department:

The Fire Department helped with the Fourth of July activities. Total Hours: 278.0 over four days.
