Life in the DPW

We hope you are able to enjoy the nice weather we have been having, not too hot nor too cold, generally speaking. This time of year, mowing of Village properties, takes up a lot of our time. Along with mowing we have been busy with monthly generator checks, patching, flushing of hydrants, water samples and reports, discharging at the WWTF, painting of parking lines, and working with our engineering firm on establishing some kind of long-term plan for our roads. Keeping our equipment serviced also takes some time but is needed in order to keep them operating longer. The restrooms at Salisbury Park have been painted and rehabilitated and should be open now. We are also prepping for the Fourth of July celebration which will be here before we know it. General spring cleanup is over but if you still have some leaves or yard debris, you may put it in paper lawn and leaf bags and we will pick them up. In way of reminder, fall is the only season in which we have the leaf vacuum out, we don't get it out in the spring. In the fall, if you choose not to rake your leaves to the road edge, that is your choice. But in the spring, those leaves and debris will need to be in lawn and leaf bags.
