One being the new Basketball Court being useable, I hope you were able to attend the ribbon cutting ceremony. The painting of the lines on the court has also been done now, in the spring the bricks will be installed. Also, until that time, in Spring, Summer and early Fall, if you have yard waste i.e., grass clippings, leaves and the like (No Sod), you will need to use biodegradable lawn and leaf bags. There are some available at the Village office for purchase if needed. Also, please remember to stack your brush parallel to the street as this makes it easier and more efficient for us to pick up. We have also been busy discharging water at the wastewater treatment facility that is until all of the rain. All of the rain we have been receiving has been good for lawns and gardens but not good for discharging as the ground is saturated at the plant and we cannot run the center pivots. We will continue to release water as we are able so as to create enough holding for the winter months. Once again, get out and enjoy the nice weather and the fresh air because soon enough we will have to spend more time inside because of the cold and, dare I say it, snow.
