- Beech Street, from 4th Street to Maple Street.

Other:

- Funding of \$410,000 from the state for the E Lake St project.
- Had a quarter mile of our storm water system documented in preparation for some much-needed upgrades, especially for the business district.
- Much-needed roof repair to municipal building.
- Recycling service available in the Village.
- Updated Website/ Email monthly newsletter directly to residents.
- Updating ordinances/organizing ordinance books in the office.
- Start of Master plan with planning commissioners.
- Pickleball court lines painted on tennis court.

- New equipment to salt Commercial District on Lake Street.
- DPW employee receiving L1, L2 Wastewater license.
- HR implemented employee paperwork to add to the employee handbook.
- The zoning administrator/enforcement position is filled.
- Full-time firefighter position filled.
- Full-time firefighter completed their fire 1 instructor course.
- 2 Firefighters received their EMT License.
- Awarded a \$40,000 grant for the Fire Department.
- Pancake breakfast fundraiser; gaining \$6,500 for fire truck fund.
- Much-needed replacement of one fire engine.
- Clerk finished year 2 of Clerk institute.
- All Cd's renewed, gaining more interest at 3.2%, Fire & General CD gaining 5% interest total.
