As a constant reminder, leaves and lawn debris must be put in lawn and leaf bags in order to be picked up. When placing sticks, twigs and brush at the road, please put it parallel to the road.

The Village will be having W. Lake Street chip sealed this year. This is typically done within two years of being paved. Thankfully, the road hasn’t degraded too much, and we will add 5-7 years of life to the road by having this work done.

You also may start to see some preliminary work being done on E. Lake Street in preparation for a rebuild next year. Surveying, soil borings and the like are some of the things that will be done this year.
