## Zoning Reminder:

### Leaf and Yard debris reminder

#### Ordinance 2005-A-1.7

**1.7.1 Burning of trash, refuse, leaves, garden waste, and other similar materials is prohibited within the Village of Sand Lake.**

**1. Traditional campfires are allowed provided an adult is present and in control of the fire at all times.**

**(e iv) Any open burning will occur entirely within a non-flammable receptacle which is not greater than 3' in diameter**

**1.7.2 A violation of this ordinance is a Municipal civil infraction for which the fine shall not be less than \$100 nor more than \$500 for the first offense**
