Event Form approval through the Village of Sand Lake:

The Village of Sand Lake is pleased to support community events that improve the quality of life and contribute to the economic vitality of the Sand Lake area. This application can benefit event organizers by allowing the use of Village property, closing of streets, use of Village water/electricity and easing of certain restrictions (noise, food-trucks, signs, temporary business permits ect.) The application fee may not include costs associated with Village provided services. To be deemed a Community Event, the event must:

- be open to the public**
- demonstrate a benefit to the Village of Sand Lake community**
 - have an estimated attendance of 50+ people**
 - be non-discriminatory**
 - be held within the Village limits**

All new community events to be held on public property shall be presented to the Village Council

for approval. The Village Council approval may require **45-60 days for approval**. The application form must be submitted by **MONDAY**, one week before the regular council meeting, to be included on the agenda for approval. Review and approval does not start until all event documentation has submitted. No set-up or road closures to begin until all required documentation has been received. Submission of this application does not guarantee approval of the community event. Submission of an incomplete application may cause delay or denial of the event. Community events which include potentially dangerous activities or dangerous road crossings may be required to provide for additional police or ambulance services as part of their application approval.

Approval of a community event is contingent upon submission of a public liability

insurance certificate naming the Village of Sand Lake as additionally insured with a

minimum single limit of personal injury and property damage of \$1,000,000.00 (one million

dollars) along with the following required docs: Any vendor contracts along with contract information for each vendor. Copy of any State applications/permits (i.e. firework display, liquor license.
